



2026 Reading Bingo Challenge

If you love reading then you might be interested in putting yourself to the test with Caroline County Library's 2026 year-long reading bingo challenge! This challenge is designed to encourage library patrons to explore and use a wide range of items from our collection. It is also meant to give that extra "push" to have you read outside your normal comfort zones and try new things in the process.

Rules are simple and the squares are easy to follow. Most are up to the participant's interpretation. There is a total of 25 squares to complete with no overlap, meaning 25 books and/or activities completed throughout the year. Those who choose to participate can claim BINGO a total of 3 times and receive three respective small prizes; however if you complete the entire card then you will be entered into a grand prize drawing where the winner will be announced in December 2026.

Ages 18+. Create a painting of your choice. No specific stencils will be given, however previous stencils and example printouts will be available. Feel free to bring your own project or idea!




